




# **Message from Head of School**

Dear GISC community members,

**GISC Parent Council** will also launch in November. You will receive an invitation to self-nominate for class representative. Each class or homeroom will have one chosen representative who will act as the parent voice on issues of concern and improvement, activities planning, and school/student welfare. Our first Parent Council meeting will be November 14.

Within the next two weeks, you will also receive a parent survey on additional **World Language** provision for 2023-24. In our admissions interviews, we promised you a voice in planning for future World Language offerings, and we encourage you to confer with your child about their interests. MAP achievement monitored throughout the year will play a significant role in personalizing growth goals for each student and will be critical to parent/teacher dialogue and conferences. You may be reading the news out of the US and other countries who are just now getting in results from various norm-referenced assessments. Worldwide, the Covid pandemic has taken an unprecedented toll on student learning.







Achievement has not just stagnated; it has regressed over the past two years. Our baseline data for GISC students supports this same finding. In most grade levels (2 through 8) and in most content areas (Reading Comprehension, Language Usage, Math) an average of 60% of our students are scoring below the world average. We join the world in tackling this enormous deficit, and we feel confident that with the GISC quality of instruction and education program, and students in school every day, we can meet the growth targets for every GISC student.

Parent Conferences/Progress Meetings will be held over several days the last full week of November. We have listened to you, our parents, who have clearly communicated that you need time with your child's teachers. We will do our best to ensure that you have time for positive and informed dialogue, with an opportunity to follow up with each teacher if further conversation is needed. Please understand that time constraints are significant, however we are committed to our first parent conferences affording you the opportunity for meaningful engagement. Look for schedule details next week.

Our third **Parent Master Class** of Term 1 will feature Hanady Fawzy, Head of Elementary, offering tips and strategies for behavior management with your child – Essential Agreements. Mark your calendars for 8:15AM on November 29.

November is a wonderful month to begin the winter holiday season with its emphasis on gratitude with the celebration of Thanksgiving. 
